Queens Road Preschool

Following the regular Church Council Meeting on 5th June 2025, an Extraordinary Church Council meeting took place on 11th June 2025 where the Managing Trustees further considered the future of Queens Road Pre-School. It is with deep sorrow that we must share the incredibly difficult news that Queens Road Preschool will be closing at the end of this academic year

It was with sadness that the Church Council recognised that families' needs for early years provision have now changed, with many seeking care from breakfast through to early evening and for children from nine months upwards. Queens Road is not in a position to offer this, and numbers have been consistently falling, with many children now attending other settings, particularly those at our local schools. Members of the church are working with our dedicated staff and families to ensure that the children continue to receive good provision for the rest of this term and that staff and families are supported when seeking other roles and settings. We are grateful that over the last 50 plus years the mission has been accomplished.

Please continue to hold in your prayers current and past staff, children, parents, together with those church members leading this process on behalf of the church.
